The CRO course includes lessons and practical exercises necessary to explain the fundamentals of mobile device investigations, extraction of user data, and the previewing of extracted mobile device data using the Cellebrite Responder Kiosk. Participants in the course perform extractions to collect data from mobile devices, SIM cards, and mass storage media. Additionally, learners complete proper documentation steps, the generation of automated reports, and the creation of custom reports.
